



David M'ore is coming with all of his 'Passion, Soul & Fire'

Yes, music fans, musician David M'ore is coming to a music store or club near you. The Argentinian-born, San Francisco, California-based artist's new album (to be reviewed here in the near future) is titled *Passion, Soul, & Fire*. He is presently busy also working on planning and prepping for future live appearances in support of the disc. But for those not familiar with M'ore, here is some background information on the artist in question:

M'ore is a singer, song writer and guitarist. He is also a former member of the disbanded group Blind Hole and a more recent winner of a Sacramento Music Award. Having

recently stirred up the press with his tuneful talents, he has recently been featured on the cover of such publications as the San Francisco Chronicle. His signature sound is a musical *mélange* of several genres including (but not necessarily limited to) the blues, rock, R&B and blues rock.

M'ore, who began studying "vintage records" as a child. Brit neoclassical hard rock and traditional blues left a lasting impression on both the artist and his personal style. In a recent e-mail M'ore stated: "I still listen to those old records from Johnny Winter. That's where it all began. "The aggressive sound of the guitar drove me emotionally insane."

He began playing the guitar at the age of eight. At present, he plays a custom-made Strat which was modified to his specifications. His personal six-string technique is reportedly evident whether he is playing cover tunes or some of his own original compositions.

M'ore adds: "I love to pay tribute to those who influenced me, but at the same time, I like to be true to who I am." His specific influences include such other performers as the late, great Jimi Hendrix, Ritchie Blackmore, Joe Satriani, Johnny Winter and Albert King. If you're a fan of guitarists and blues rock in general, you might want to keep an eye out for M'ore who may be coming to a venue near you in the near future.
